



Instructions for New Mold Patients

First Office Visit

We are happy to see you as a new patient and help get you on the path to wellness. Our practice treats patients in a different way than most physician's as we try to get to cause of your disease and illness and not just treat your symptoms. Practicing in this detailed, specialized way has led some of the sickest patients to us from all regions. These patients's, probably like yourself, tend to have many severe allergies, especially to molds and fungi. We keep our waiting room and exam rooms' allergy and fungi free with the most advanced air quality and environmental control measures available. The air has to be free of molds and antigens so patients do not have asthma attacks and severe allergy response. The only way we can accomplish this is to educate new patients before the appointment and require they follow the protocol. Failure to follow these instructions could result in your appointment being rescheduled or cancelled.

1. Call Pavilion Pharmacy 404-350-5780 and get a mold plate test kit and follow the very detailed instructions that come with it. Pavilion can mail you this or you can pick it up. They are in the same building as us. The rooms to test are bedroom, den, kitchen, attic, basement and car. If you do not have a basement or an attic, test the room or area where the HVAC(s) are located. Send them in to Immunolytics Mold Lab. Put Dr. Dennis's name on the requisition sheet as referring doctor and we will get an email with your results. Do this at least 10 to 14 days prior to your scheduled appointment so we have the results. This is very important and is a requirement for your treatment.
2. Also get some "EC3 Laundry Additive" from Pavilion. This is the detergent you will use for your clothing you will be wearing when you come to y our first visit. Before using this you need to decontaminate your washing machine by running it on the smallest cycle with hot water and 1 cup of bleach. NO clothes in the washer just the bleach and hot water. Then run a small cycle with hot water and 1 cup of baking soda. NO clothes just the mixture. After that you can wash the outfit you plan to wear to our office. After you wash it do not put it in with the other clothes it will become contaminated again. You put it in a plastic container with a plastic lid closed and this will keep them mold free to wear to the office.
3. The day of the appointment, right before you will be leaving your home, shower and shampoo as usual then immediately before exiting your house put on the clothes. This way you will be able to be in the waiting area around other patients and we won't have to be concerned about our more sensitive patients and staff.

We realize this is an unusual request and we appreciate your thoughtfulness and cooperation in this very serious matter. Call our office if you have any questions.
